- Years 8-10 Mathematics and/or science
- Capacity to teach learning-support, literacy and Religious Education could also be an advantage.
- Combinations of the above will be considered for the right candidate
- Candidates must be available 5 days a week.

Essential Requirements

- Appropriate tertiary education qualification and current TRB, and WWC check.
- Presentation of COVID Vaccination Digital Certificate
- Well-developed written, verbal and ICT communication skills
- Availability for staff meetings before and after school, according to FTE load
- Be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic Education WA, the Code of Conduct and Executive Directives and Policy and Procedural statements of CEWA Ltd and St Clare's School.
- A learning disposition to working with young people with complex needs

Preferred Requirements

- Preferred 5 years teaching experience
- Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School
- Familiarity with theory and practice of a trauma-informed care, and/or Positive Psychology/Education
